For example, a participant may submit 1 Birthday card design and 1 Wedding card design but not 2 Birthday card designs.


Technical Requirements


Artwork Size: 8 x 8 cm when folded and 16 x 8 cm when flat.

Artwork Format: JPEG.

Artwork Resolution: 300 DPI
